

Reforms Implemented in the Spiritual and Cultural Sphere in New Uzbekistan

Today, by implementing the strategy of spiritual and cultural reforms in New Uzbekistan, increasing the spiritual and educational level of our people, together with social, economic and political factors, delivering the reforms implemented in the spiritual and educational spheres to the people.

INTRODUCTION

Today, the implementation of the strategy of spiritual and cultural reforms in the development of the new Uzbekistan serves the implementation of comprehensive measures to raise the spiritual and educational level of our people, strengthen the material and technical base of culture and art institutions, and support representatives of the field. As stated by the head of our state, Shavkat Mirziyoyev, "In addition to social, economic and political factors, the reforms implemented in the spiritual and educational spheres are also very important in the development strategy of the new Uzbekistan. We all understand well that if the body of society is economy, then its soul and spirit is spirituality. We rely on these two strong pillars in building a new Uzbekistan, that is, a strong economy based on market principles and a strong spirituality embodying the rich heritage of our ancestors, national and universal ideas".[1]

DISCUSSION

The importance of the concept of continuous spiritual education in raising spiritual and educational work in our country to a new level, studying the state of the social and spiritual environment and improving it, educating young people in the spirit of love for the Motherland and devotion to the profession, and realizing ideological security in the conditions of globalization Issues of security, the impact of social networks on the spiritual and moral education of the population, especially young people, and the development of technologies for the formation of ideological immunity against threats to the spirituality of young people are becoming important.

The President's decree of May 3, 2019 "On additional measures to increase the effectiveness of spiritual and educational work" and March 26, 2021 "Measure to radically improve the system of spiritual and educational work" Within the framework of the festival held in order to ensure the implementation of the decisions on "activities", practical seminars, roundtable discussions were held based on the principle of "Each intellectual is a mentor to five young people", "One

intellectual is a spiritual patron of one neighborhood". was held and many other projects in the spiritual and educational direction were implemented.

The relevance of the reforms implemented in the spiritual and cultural sphere in new Uzbekistan is reflected in the following:

firstly, it requires the development of a road map for the regulation of relations in the spiritual and cultural sphere, the legal status of cultural and artistic institutions, creative associations and associations, and the introduction of reforms aimed at social protection of creators to a new stage of development;

secondly, to create a thorough system for the training of highly qualified personnel in the spiritual and cultural sphere and to improve their qualifications, to meet the growing cultural needs of the population and to sharply improve the quality of cultural services;

thirdly, adapting the material and technical base of spiritual, cultural and art institutions to modern requirements and international standards, opening the way for their full activity;

fourthly, the fact that our national culture has not taken a proper place in the modern media space, and information and communication technologies have not been fully introduced into the field, shows the need for extensive research and promotion of the field, as well as the need to integrate it into international cultural processes at the required level;

fifth, to consistently ensure the participation of our artists in prestigious international festivals and contests in the field of spirituality, culture and art and to display their masterpieces, to create an effective system of exporting national creative products, and to sufficiently establish cooperation with foreign organizations.

Science, science and education are the path that leads a person, the whole society and the state to happiness and light. An investment in education now is an investment in the future. Therefore, priority is given to education in our country.

Positive changes in the education system, in turn, require the improvement of the legal framework of the field. Today, radical improvement of the education sector has become the demand of the time. Based on this demand, laws regulating relations in the field of education are being adopted. In particular, on September 23, 2020, the new version of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Education" was adopted, through which relations in the field of education in New Uzbekistan rose to a new level.[2]

Another important reform in the spiritual and cultural sphere of new Uzbekistan was the adoption of the "Concept of Continuous Spiritual Education" on December 31, 2019. Because this concept envisages increasing the knowledge and pedagogical culture of the population on child education, regularly familiarizing citizens with the effective methods and forms of implementation of continuous spiritual education. The goal of the concept is to bring up a high-quality, well-rounded generation based on the gradual formation of social skills and qualities necessary for an independent life in the young generation.[3]

The concept covers four stages:

- first stage: in families (fetal period, period from birth to 3 years);
- second stage: preschool education up to 3-6 (7) years;
- third stage: general secondary education (primary class up to 7 (6)-10 years old, 11-17 (18) years old);

the fourth stage: young people who are active in production and are not employed, as well as young people in the secondary specialized profession and OTM system.

A new stage of the quality of education in our country was announced by our President Shavkat Mirziyoyev on January 20, 2023 at an extended meeting on the development of foreign languages and vocational training system in schools. education was set as a priority task.

As an experiment, school graduates will be trained in 20 professions at the expense of the "Young Future" fund, 37 professions by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation, and 18 professions by the Ministry of Pre-school and School Education. It was planned to be conducted in all schools of the region, based on the available opportunities and needs, 64 professions in 8 areas of specialization will be taught in the schools of the region in order to prepare students for professions.

Starting from the 2023-2024 school year, one in each district (city) will teach French in 13 schools, including Romitan, Karakol, Olot, Shafirkon and Qarovulbazar districts, German in Kogon city, Kogon, Jondor and Peshku districts, Bukhara English will be taught in the city, Vobkent and Gijduvan districts, and Korean will be taught in the Bukhara district. In order to improve the knowledge and skills of more than 3,000 foreign language teachers working in general education schools, it was decided to organize educational seminars and targeted training courses. Production masters and skilled craftsmen of professional educational institutions located in the region are involved in the processes of preparing school graduates for professions. It is envisaged that students will be trained in more than 10 modern professions (creative industry) using the available opportunities in the information technology rooms of general education schools. .

Also, it should be noted that as a result of large-scale reforms in the field of higher education, the number of our universities has been increasing in recent years, and the goal is to increase them further. In particular, it is worth noting that 41 universities were given academic and financial independence and transformation offices were opened in order to improve the quality of education of universities in our country and to fundamentally develop their activities. In the next year, the resources for preferential educational loans for university students will be doubled and 1.7 trillion soums will be allocated, and the efforts in this regard will create a wide opportunity for our youth, especially the children of families in need of social protection, our daughters, and their with the help of preferential education loans, they can get higher education and get the profession they want. This, in turn, will increase the coverage of the youth of our country with higher education.

It should be noted that 1.5 trillion soums are expected to be allocated to science and innovation next year. These funds, which are almost 6 times more than in 2017, play an important role in supporting young people and representatives of science who are looking for science and want to implement various innovative ideas. Also, a 4.5-fold increase in the salary of scientists will be a great incentive for science devotees.[4]

The reforms carried out in all spheres in our country pay special attention to the development of national culture along with all spheres. In particular, to increase the spiritual and educational level and knowledge of our people, to preserve tangible and intangible cultural heritage objects, to bring active integration into the field of world culture, to strengthen the material and technical base of culture and art institutions, to support representatives of the field - complex measures aimed at support are being implemented.

President Shavkat Mirziyoyev's "On approval of the concept of further development of national culture in the Republic of Uzbekistan", "On measures to radically improve activities in the field of protection of tangible cultural heritage", "Culture of the Republic of Uzbekistan The decree "On measures to improve the activity of the Ministry" and the decree "On measures to further increase the role and influence of the sphere of culture and art in the life of the society" are undoubtedly new in the field of culture. achievements, spurred changes and reforms.

In particular, the concept of further development of national culture in the Republic of Uzbekistan is to preserve historical and cultural heritage in the new Uzbekistan, to inculcate national and universal values in the minds of young people, to preserve ethnic cultural traditions, and to widely introduce modern information and communication technologies in the field of culture., organization and development of mutually effective international relations in the field of culture, viewing national culture as a structural and integral part of world culture, ensuring the full functioning of cultural and art institutions, further strengthening their material and technical base, cultural heritage intended to serve to establish public control over the preservation of its objects.[5]

Also, in order to increase the effectiveness of legal regulation in the field of culture, on January 20, 2021, the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Cultural Activities and Cultural Organizations" was adopted. The purpose of this law is to regulate relations in the field of cultural activities and activities of cultural organizations. It is also worth noting that before the adoption of this law, legal relations in the field of cultural activities were regulated by several regulatory legal documents, including "On the export and import of cultural assets", "On museums" and It was regulated by the laws "On the protection and use of cultural heritage objects" and many other legal documents.

When it comes to the preservation of cultural objects, in the last five years, we have witnessed a significant increase in the civil position of society in matters related to the preservation of historical and cultural heritage. Residents began to strongly oppose the demolition of historical buildings, especially the construction of high-rise buildings in the historical part of the city. Public control, which is a general indicator of the formation of civil society in the country, has increased.

It should be recognized that the Museum renovation program, which envisages innovative reorganization of museums, was approved as part of the sector reform. Khorazm "Lazgi", an example of the ancient and unique art of the Uzbek people, was included in the representative list of UNESCO's intangible cultural heritage under the name "Khorazm dance - Lazgi". Over the past period, support for the creators of Uzbekistan was provided by the Ilhom public fund, the Fund for the Development of Culture and Art under the Ministry of Culture, the Union of Composers and Composers of Uzbekistan, the State Philharmonic of Uzbekistan, Uzbekistan the Fergana regional branch of the state art and culture institute was established.

The reforms implemented in the spiritual and cultural sphere in new Uzbekistan are clearly visible in various festivals and demonstrations organized in our country. For example, on September 10-15, 2019, the first International Handicrafts Festival will be held in the city of Ko'kan under the auspices of UNESCO, the status of "City of Craftsmen of the World" will be granted to the city of Ko'kan by the International Organization of Craftsmen, the high international level of Uzbek folk art there was recognition.[6]

Many of the world's festivals took place in the forums such as the International Gifting Art held in Termiz, the International Art of Status held in Shahrisabz, as well as "Silk and Spices" in Bukhara and "Atlas Bayram" in Margilon. The participation of representatives of culture and art from their countries, in particular, famous scientists and experts who spread fame with their scientific work and practical activities in the field of handicrafts, deserves special attention.

One of the reforms carried out in the spiritual and cultural sphere in new Uzbekistan is the development of bakhshik, which is considered an ancient art form, further development of its school and traditions, showing its importance in raising the culture of our people, by increasing attention to the school of bakhshik. reforms in the education of talented young people interested in horse racing.

A system of preservation and development of unique examples of Uzbek classical and folk art, unique performance schools and traditions has been created. The Uzbek national status art center and museum was established. The holding of the International Status Art Conference and the

International Festival of Giving Art every two years was an important practical step towards increasing the prestige of our unique heritage at the world level.

In 2002, the "Boysun Spring" International Folklore Festival, which was held in Surkhandarya, which was famous as the land of Bakhshis, was founded in 2002, and the first "Boysun Spring" open folklore festival was held. Folk groups of our country participated in it with their special programs. In 2017, the festival of fine art under the open sky, which stopped in 2004, was revived.

At the festival held in accordance with the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated February 7, 2022 "On measures to organize and hold the international folklore festival "Boysun Spring", dignitaries from more than 30 countries of the world, industry experts, artists and fans participated. The masters of folk art of our country, the artists of Great Britain, France, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, and Tajikistan performed the most beautiful works of folk art and national traditions in the festival where national values were glorified. sang with This festival, which is held traditionally, provides an opportunity to ensure the development of folk art, to demonstrate the rich cultural, material and intangible heritage at the international level.

For example, the 2nd International Festival of Giving Art, which was held at a high level in Nukus on September 17, 2021, turned into a holiday of national heritage, culture and art, and the art lovers not only in our country, but also abroad, aroused great interest. International art historians have repeatedly recognized that this art form is an important art direction in the civilization of Central Asian culture.[7]

One of the notable festivals in the spiritual and cultural sphere of New Uzbekistan was the "National Souvenirs" festival held on October 28, 2021 in all regions of the country. In this festival, the aim of the festival is to promote the cultural and historical heritage of our country among the citizens and foreign visitors, and to make a worthy contribution to the efforts being made to strengthen the image of our country as a safe destination for travel and recreation. -artisans from the cities participated with their national exhibitions. This will serve for the sustainable socio-economic development of the regions, to ensure the employment of artisans and to support them both materially and morally.

On April 27-29, 2023, the GreenArt international landscape art eco-festival was held in Tashkent. His mission was to increase environmental culture and draw public attention to the problems of ecology and greening in the country. Here, along with enjoying the beauty of nature, they also got detailed information about the care of fruit and ornamental trees. Experts will share information about varieties of horticultural crops, flowering periods, methods of flower propagation, peculiarities of care and watering.

Also, mutual debates were organized on interesting topics such as scientific achievements, introduction of innovative technologies, planting of ornamental trees suitable for local climatic conditions, increase of green avenues, development of "green economy".[8]

RESULTS

In accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On measures to further increase the role and influence of the sphere of culture and art in the life of society", the preservation of intangible cultural heritage objects and their use zi was included in the list of types of activities for which temporary work permits are issued to citizens.

Starting from September 2020, the first Sunday of every month was announced as "open door day" in state museums. On that day, citizens will be admitted to state museums free of charge to see museum objects and museum collections.

Deep study of the ancient and rich history of our country, activation of scientific and research activities in this direction, education of the young generation based on national values and priceless heritage of our ancestors, formation of a sense of patriotism and pride in one's people in

the society. "History of Uzbekistan" television channel was established in order to strengthen the sense of understanding of the country and expand the worldview of our compatriots.

The Tashkent International Film Festival of Asian, African and Latin American countries, which was held in Uzbekistan from 1968 to 1997, has been revived, and now the film festival will be held every year from September 28 to October 3 from 2021 under the name of the Tashkent International Film Festival "Masterpiece of the Silk Road". It will be held in Tashkent.

It is worth noting that in recent years in our country, large-scale work has been carried out to study the life and work of enlighteners and to promote it among young people, and films are being shot. For example, the films dedicated to the life of Mahmudhoja Behbudi, Abdulla Avloni, and Ibrat depict the era in which enlightened scientists lived, the outlook of the people of that time, their difficult life path, and their activities not only as political and public figures. as well as his unique legacy in Uzbek literature is emphasized.

Also, by order of "Uzbekkino" National Agency, "Cholpon. A documentary film "Bird memory" is planned to be shot. This film is dedicated to the life and work of the accomplished writer, great enlightened poet and writer Abdulhamid Sulayman son of Cholpon, and in connection with the tasks given by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev during his visit to the Avenue of Writers in 2020 "People is being filmed under the series "Heart".

Another innovation in the spiritual and cultural sphere of our country was the opening of the "Dostlik" culture and recreation park in Tashkent city on October 21, 2021. This place was built as a place for cultural and educational events that embody the development traditions of multi-ethnic Uzbekistan. There is no doubt that this place will serve to further strengthen inter-ethnic relations.

CONCLUSION

So, the dynamics of spiritual renewal in the society serves to unite every person in the path of good goals, and in this way, the national idea, national spirituality becomes a practical program of every nation. Today, the most important tasks to be carried out in our country have been determined based on the setting of the ambitious goal "From national recovery to national growth" and the requirements of the new era of development.

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
